

Overview of CLHIA


- The CLHIA is a voluntary association representing 99 percent of Canada's life and health insurance business
- Approx 24 m Canadians covered through Extended Health Care (EHC) private plans



Key stakeholder in healthcare system

• Private health insurance accounts for roughly 13% of total health care spending (16% if we include income replacement costs).

2013 Total Direct Health Care Spending (\$177.5 B)



Employers balance all of their benefits to attract and retain employees, as well as to ensure a healthy and productive workforce

Group Benefit Plan considerations

- Offering benefits is voluntary for employers
- Private plans are supplemental to public plans
- Rising employee benefit costs are creating concerns regarding the sustainability of plans
- Fraud and abuse contributes to cost concerns
- Employers seeking more aggressive cost management
- Medically necessary services or supplies
