Financial Assistance Program Background

- Easter Seals has been providing financial assistance to families since the 1930's
- Funding Financial Assistance is based on donor dollars
- Easter Seals acts as the third party funder
- The Program is centralized through the Provincial Office and follows a set criteria



What is Funded?

- Mobility Equipment: Wheelchairs, walkers, standers
- Communication Devices: ADP funded computers
- Orthotics: leg braces
- Accessibility Equipment: Ceiling track lift systems, van lifts, ramps
- Bathing/Toileting Equipment: bath lifts, commode chairs

Camping & Recreation

Programs

- Easter Seals has been operating residential summer camps since 1937
- Easter Seals owns and operates two camps: Easter Seals Merrywood and Woodeden
- The Recreational Choices Funding program
- Funding for both programs is based on donor dollars
- Child must be registered with Easter Seals

Residential Summer Camps

- Recreational camping program for children/youth between the ages of 8 to 18 years who meet the criteria
- Family Camp is available for children/youth and their families. Children who do not meet the criteria for individual camp are encouraged to attend Family Camp











Recreational Choices Funding Program

- Funds are to be used for a recreational program in the summer of the parents/child's choice, e.g. Residential or Day Camp, swimming lessons, sports camp
- Funds available to children/youth between the ages of 5 to 18 years on the Easter Seals registry



Incontinence Supplies Grant Program

- Easter Seals Ontario administers the program on behalf of the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care
- Eligibility criteria, payment schedules and funding levels for the program are set by the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care
- Program is fully funded by the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care
